PLAYER NOTES

WR JAMISON CROWDER



Crowder led the team with 47 receiving yards and two touchdowns on five receptions. Crowder's two touchdowns match a single-game career high and mark his second career multi-touchdown performance. **Crowder** leads the team this season in receptions (40), receiving yards (503) and is tied for the team lead in touchdowns (three).

LB NEVILLE HEWITT



Hewitt led the team with 12 tackles and added a sack, a QB hit and a tackle for loss, notching his fourth game of 10+ tackles this season. Hewitt now owns 101 tackles on the season, notching his first season of 100+ tackles and the first by a Jet since 2018. Hewitt's 101 tackles so far this season are the most by a Jet through 12 games since 2009 (David Harris, 105).

RB TY JOHNSON



Johnson finished the game with 104 rushing yards and a touchdown on 21 carries (4.9 avg.) while adding two catches for 13 yards. With his performance, **Johnson** established a career high and notched his first career 100-yard performance. **Johnson's** 104 yards are the most by a Jet in their first 25 career games since Bilal Powell posted 149 vs. BUF in 2013.

BY THE NUMBERS

The Jets have scored on six consecutive opening drives dating back to Week Seven vs. BUF (10/25), currently the longest active streak in the NFL. The six-game streak is also tied for the longest streak in franchise history.

DL **Quinnen Williams** has been effective against both the run and the pass this season. He now owns 6.0 sacks and 12 run stuffs on the season. His 6.0 sacks are tied for the third most among interior defensive linemen this season, and he is one of six players with 5+ sacks and 10+ run stuffs this season.

The Jets defense registered two takeaways in the contest, notching the fifth game this season with multiple takeaways (Weeks 1, 4, 6, 12 and 13). The Jets are one of only eight teams with 5+ games with multiple takeaways this season.

40+

WR **Denzel Mims** finished the game with 40 yards on two receptions (20.0 avg.). He has now registered at least 40 receiving yards in each of his first six career games, becoming only the seventh player since the NFL merger in 1970 to start his career with six straight games of 40+ receiving yards.

- CB **Javelin Guidry** registered two forced fumbles in the game, tied for the most forced fumbles in a game by a Jet since 2000. **Guidry's** performance was only the 11th time since 2000 that a Jets player has registered two forced fumbles in a game. He added six tackles in the contest.
- WR **Denzel Mims** has now pulled in at least one reception of 20+ yards in five straight games. Only Allen Robinson (10) Julio Jones (6) and Terry McLaurin (6) own longer active streaks.
- DL **Quinnen Williams** has logged 11 consecutive games with at least three tackles, the second-longest active streak in the NFL. **Williams** finished the game with four tackles, a sack, three quarterback hits and one tackle for loss.
- CB **Arthur Maulet** registered his second career interception, picking off a pass by QB Derek Carr in the 1st quarter and returning it 20 yards.
